Dear Friends

When we began work three years ago on the new science building and courtyard, the building which had housed the Brothers of the Sacred Heart had to be demolished. At the same time, we demolished a structure which had been put in place to serve the needs of students who came to McGill Institute in the 50's – a bicycle shed! Over the years, that bicycle rack had been replaced, and the area behind the McGill Building had come to serve as an outdoor eating area for students.

While we don't need bicycle racks anymore, we still need additional parking for our students. With the growth of our metropolitan area to the west and to the eastern shore, our parents have come to depend more and more on the availability of student parking. I am happy to announce that, shortly after Mardi Gras, we are planning to begin construction on a new parking lot on the corner of Old Shell and Catherine. Not only will this new lot provide over 75 new parking spaces, it will greatly enhance the beauty of our campus area. Over the last few years, we have been able to acquire three parcels of property, the last of which was the site of the former Food Max. I think it is safe to say that our new parking lot, which will be beautifully landscaped and surrounded by metal fencing, will be a great improvement over the convenience store!

The construction of the new parking lot is a project of the capital campaign. When we reach the point that we are able to build our new student center contiguous to the gym, we will need to replace the parking spaces which currently exist there, and this new lot will serve that purpose.

Thank you for your continued support of McGill-Toolen, and please pray for us as we continue to make improvements to our programs and facilities.

## A Second Homecoming

World War II veteran, John Carey, MI '37, flew to Washington, DC, on May 12, 2010 with a group of his fellow veterans aboard HonorFlight III to view the World War II Memorial. Carey was a "glider rider" in the European Theater and was involved in the Battle of the Bulge and D-Day.

Their chartered flight left Mobile around 5:30 am. They arrived in DC an hour and a half later and were greeted by an honor guard of US Marines, Senator Jeff Sessions and Representative Jo Bonner. A police escort took the group to the WWII Memorial, dedicated in 2004. They also visited the monuments to the Korean and Vietnam conflicts. Carey described the faces of the soldiers depicted in the Iwo Jima Monument as so realistic they looked as if they would talk to you. The last stop was Arlington Cemetery where they laid a wreath at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. The veterans were treated to a hero's welcome upon their return to Mobile at approximately 7:30 pm by thousands of local residents, the Azalea Trail Maids, the Oakleigh Belles and another honor guard of US Marines.

HonorFlight South Alabama (HSFA) is the local affiliate of HonorFlight which originated in Ohio in 2005. It is a non-profit
