

MISSION STATEMENT

McGill-Toolen Catholic High School provides a quality secondary education which enables individuals to grow in faith, to search for knowledge and truth in mind, body and spirit, and continue building the kingdom of God on earth.

By active involvement in the learning process, students are prepared for lives of Christian leadership and service.

Admission Policy

Students who have a satisfactory academic, disciplinary and attendance record are eligible for admission to McGill-Toolen Catholic High School. The applicant is accepted on the basis of his/her previous academic performance, recommendations of teachers and/or principals and the student's desire to profit from the moral, spiritual, academic and physical programs offered by the school. The school does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, sex, national origin or ethnic origin. Students asked to leave a previous school are generally not considered for admission.

Parents and students accept the authority of McGill-Toolen Catholic High School to deal with violations of the school code in a manner reflecting the spirit and letter of the school code. Parents and students are expected to make themselves aware of all rules and regulations at the school. Students are expected to abide by all rules and regulations.

ADMISSION PROCEDURES

Ninth Grade Admission

An applicant for the freshman year must have satisfactorily completed the eighth grade of elementary school.

The following are needed to complete the admission process:

- an application for admission with \$100 non-refundable application fee
- Tuition Payment Option Form and Registration Agreement
- official transcripts from the elementary school
- completed school health form, drug screening form, Alabama certificate of immunization
- scores from the placement test administered by McGill-Toolen.

In some cases personal interviews are required.

Transfer Students

A valid reason must exist for the transfer of a student to McGill-Toolen Catholic High School.

The following procedures are followed for those students applying:

- a completed application for admission with \$100 non-refundable application fee, an official transcript,
a current report card demonstrating the student's academic record in secondary school to date, any standardized test information and a completed drug screening form must be on file
- parents and student are interviewed by the Admission Committee in order to obtain a profile of the student's academic, disciplinary and attendance history
- the Admission Committee makes its recommendation on the student's application for admission to the Principal
- the parent(s) and student are notified in a timely manner of the final decision.

McGill-Toolen Catholic does not accept transfer students from within the Mobile area into the twelfth grade.

Currently Enrolled Students

Pre-registration of all currently enrolled students takes place in the Spring of the current year. Admission for the next year will be contingent on successful completion of academic work and an evaluation of disciplinary and attendance records done at the end of the current school year. Those not being readmitted will be notified by June 15.
